

## Liberal Arts and Sciences General Education Degree Planning Guidelines

A minimum of 30 semester credits in **the liberal arts and science** is required. As part of your planning process for the Master of Arts in Teaching Program, please complete this form with your advisor. The courses listed below are examples of the kinds of courses that would fulfill the 30 semester credit hours in the liberal arts and sciences general education requirement. These courses or their equivalents should be a minimum of 3 credits each unless otherwise noted.

<b>Social Science (3 cr.)</b> <b>Examples:</b> Psychology Sociology History					
<b>History (3 cr.)</b> <b>Examples:</b> Courses in any area of historical study					
<b>Humanities (3 cr.)</b> <b>Examples:</b> Literature Philosophy Art History					
<b>Information Retrieval (3 cr.)</b> <b>Examples:</b> Library Studies Research courses Computer Literacy Educational Technology					
<b>Mathematics (3 cr.)</b> <b>Examples:</b> Courses in mathematics, including statistics					
<b>Science (3 cr.)</b> <b>Examples:</b> Courses in the natural sciences
