Submit application and a budget sheet by e-mail to Mary Morton, affirmative action officer, at mary.morton@esc.edu. The Diversity/Inclusion Committee members will review all applications and allocate funds.

Applications for fiscal year 2013-14 must be **submitted by April 8, 2013 for consideration**. Committee members will make funding decisions during the following week and applicants will be notified of the committee's decision.

The maximum amount awarded to an office, center or program is \$2,000 in a single fiscal year.

Future eligibility for Community Outreach Grants requires the submission of an evaluation of the funded activity shortly after the funding period has concluded.
